Miscellaneous

The question by Jack Brandt about the meaning of the label "BY DIRECT BAG" has received extensive answers by two members, Don Rodell and Eric J. Frazer.

This label is listed in the catalogue *The Official Postal Labels of Australia* by Eric J. Frazer and Robin C. Occlshaw (Sydney, 1999 2nd ed.).

Mr Frazer, one of the authors, had sent the catalogue entry:

BY DIRECT BAG		[Form number unknown]			
The Army introduced a special red label with white lettering for its Direct Bag Mail, most of which appears to have gone by registered air mail during the period February 1943 to late 1945. The illustration shows a mint block which may be one of the largest in existence; less than a dozen covers are thought to exist.

Mr Rodell comments as follows:

"These labels appear to be exclusive to Army use via their own transport without using PMG (Post Office). The service did not have regular or widespread use and was allowed to lapse after original supply was exhausted. (This perhaps explains their scarcity)...I have 2 covers bearing this label neither of which is registered."
