About parcel card labels

In the previous issue 118, labels were shown under the heading of 'Cinderella labels'. However, on closer inspection this is not the right category. Cinderella labels are not issued by the official postal service and they are not meant to function in the processing of postal items. The labels in issue 118 on the other hand have a function in the postal handling and therefore are postal labels. A great variety of these labels can be found particularly on parcel cards, albeit not exclusively. To get some ordering I make a distinction between (i) labels providing indications for transport and delivery of postal items, and (ii) labels providing indications for the material characteristics of the postal items (mainly parcels). Of the first category I gave some examples in issue 119, like 'valeur déclarée', 'franc de droits', etc. Of the second category I want to give some examples here. Important are two kinds of indications UPU mentions in its Parcel Post Manual (Bern 2013): fragile and cumbersome parcels. In the section 'Marking of fragile parcels and of cumbersome parcels', I cite first:

- 5.1 Without prejudice to compliance with the general rules regarding make-up and packing, every fragile parcel shall be provided, either by the sender or by the office of origin, with a label featuring a picture of a glass printed in red on a white background.
- 5.2 The relative dispatch note shall bear very conspicuously on the front the indication "Colis fragile" (Fragile parcel) either in manuscript or printed

on a label.

I know this quotation only dates from 2013, but the regulation is much older.

Unfortunately of what is required according 5.1 I haven't an example, because wrappings of parcels with labels on it are very hard to come by. Much easier is it to get parcel cards. However, I have only one card with the exact requirement of 5.2:



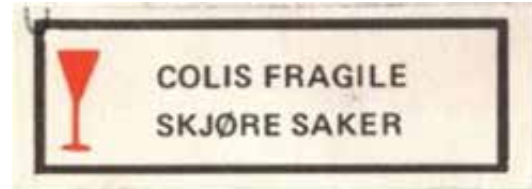
This regards a parcel from Germany to Belgium, dated 1970-9-9. The card has the required label 'Colis fragile'. Quite often other indications are used like for instance the glass image as prescribed in 5. 1. Here is an example:



Not even the picture of a glass seems necessary; the word 'fragile' suffices. This is, however, not a parcel card, but the postal item itself.



A parcel card from Switzerland to Germany, dated 1963. A lot of this kind of cards can be found. Apparently the UPU regulation is not followed strictly.



Here are some labels with also “fragile” in the domestic language. Anyone may produce these fragile-labels, just like AML’s. But when a reference number is present I assume it is issued by the official postal service.



Dutch language, meaning: heavy + fragile

The UPU regulation for cumbersome parcels is:

5.4 Every cumbersome parcel and the front of its dispatch note shall bear a label showing in bold letters the word “Encombrant” (Cumbersome).

5.5 Designated operators which admit the limits of sizes set out in article RC 115.1 may charge as cumbersome any parcel whose dimensions exceed the limits set out in article RC 115.2 but which weighs less than 10 kilogrammes. In such a case, the word “Encombrant” shall be supplemented on the dispatch note only by the words “en vertu de l’article RC 135.5.5” (pursuant to article RC 135.5.5).

Up till now I have never seen a parcel card with this supplement.

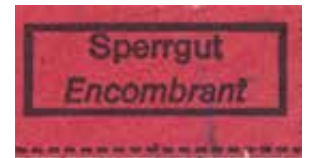
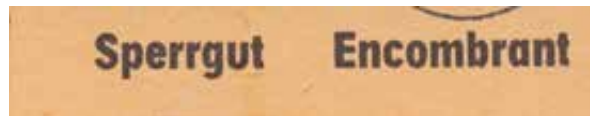


A parcel card attached to a parcel from Switzerland to Germany, dated 1990. The label is worded in the three languages of Switzerland: French, German, and Italian.

Connected with the label on the parcel card is a large label to be put on the cumbersome parcel itself. I have two examples:

All the labels I have found up till now are from European countries. It would be very helpful to hear from our members about instances used in other parts of the world.

Special attention should be given to Czechoslovakian parcel cards. The label on the card you can see here, was an enigma for me. But from two sides the riddle was solved.

Via Peter Morgen the answer was given by Mr. Werner Müller, the former chairman of the Czech collectors group in Germany.

ENC stands for Colis **ENC**ombrant = cumbersome in French.

NSK means the same, but in Czech language: **NeSK**ladné.

Later on the same answer was pointed out to me in *Czechout*.

Journal of the Czechoslovak Philatelic Society of Great Britain, Sept. 2007, vol. 25, nr. 3. It is an article by Richard Wheatley about Parcel Card Stickers.

I think it is only used in domestic mail, but I am not certain.

Of course, there is a variety:



Under the heading of 'Special packing' the Parcel Post Manual mentions another label:

The wrapping of the parcel containing live animals as well as the dispatch note shall be provided with a label bearing in bold letters the words "Animaux vivants" (Live animals).

Here a Dutch label: a large one to put on the parcel and the small one for the parcel card. Unfortunately, it is mint. I have never seen it on a parcel card.



Of some Belgian ones I did find the parcel card. These labels are much more fun:



This label is the large one destined for the parcel itself. I found it however attached to a parcel card.



I think this is part of also a large label.

Who knows more?

Kevin Burt asks for information:

The Western Australian "Compensation" labels are very rare. I personally have not seen a copy despite collecting Australian registration labels for 15 years. They were issued at Perth Parcels Office only, probably during the era of State issued registration labels (1908 to 1925), but no dates of usage are known. Some were perforated, some rouletted, in sheets of 10. Bob Turley recorded their use in "The Australian Stamp Monthly" in 1973, stating that 15 versions are known, some of which I illustrate below. The label in colour comes from a friend and is "off paper". The other illustrations are from Turley's articles. Do any readers have any further information, or examples with dates?
