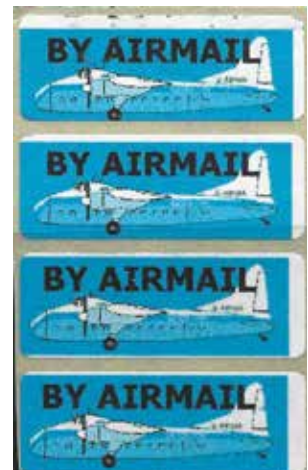

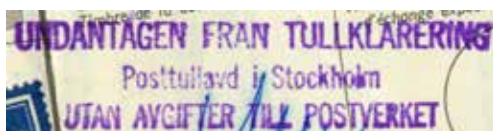
“The Messenger Delivery service superseded the Special Delivery service. Its purpose was to expedite delivery of postal articles from the delivery Post Office to the addressee, and could be requested by the sender or the addressee. The service commenced on 20 July 1970 and finally ceased operation on 25 August 1986.”



This purple Swedish label was shown earlier in PLB 118 and it says: delivery on Saturday.

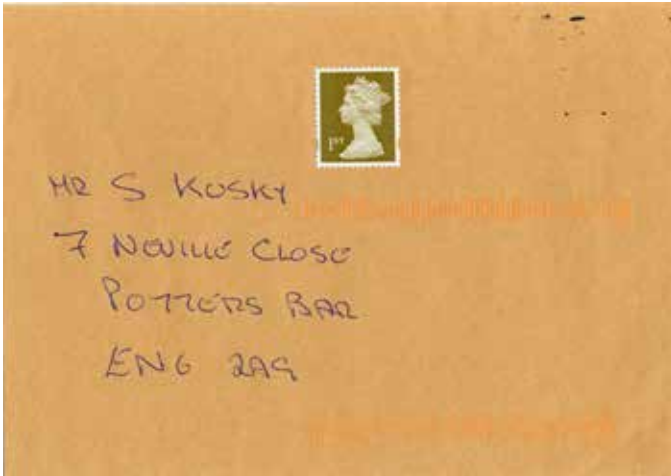
On the parcel card from Italy to Sweden this label has real significance because the parcel arrived in Sweden on January 19th, 1980 and this was a Friday.

Normally in this case the parcel would be delivered on the next Monday, but apparently the addressee wished to have his parcel immediately. I assume that extra costs are implied but there is no account of it on the parcel card itself.



At the postoffice in Stockholm it has been established: free from customs duties and no costs to be paid for this postal service.

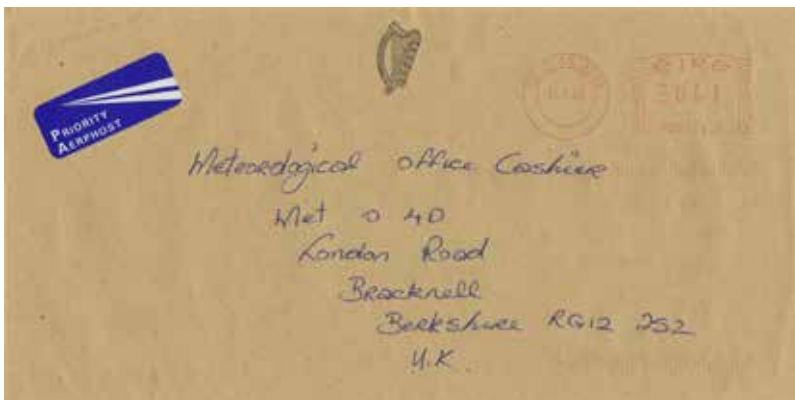

On the back of the envelope a label has been put by the sender declaring that the letter "does not contain any dangerous or prohibited goods". This label is issued by the Irish postal service An Post. I have seen this kind of declaration as a marking but never as a postal label.

Airmail labels

Air Mail Etiquettes of Mexico prior to World War II

Like virtually all other countries, the first airmail labels were issued by the government. Mexico's first appeared in 1927. (Figures 1 & 2)

The development of airlines and air routes in Mexico was very complex, beginning with the establishment of the C.M.A. (Compania Mexicana de Aviacion) in 1924 as a local carrier of payrolls in the Tampico area. By 1928 they had extended the route to Mexico City and added a new one from Vera Cruz to Merida. C.M.A. was acquired by Pan American in 1929, adding a U.S. connection at Brownsville, Texas. Figure 3 shows C.M.A.'s first etiquette, a die-cut airplane, issued at the time of the Exposicion de Aeronautica, Comercio e Industria in 1931. The label at the upper left was issued by Mexico's second airline, C.A.T. (Compania Aeronautica de Transportes) in 1930. The Panama promotional label at the lower left commemorates the joining of C.A.M. and Panama. It is quite unusual to have etiquettes of two different companies on one envelope.

C.A.T. released a second label, also in 1930, specifying its name. (Figure 4)

C.A.M., in 1938, issued a type very similar to that used by Panama at the time, with the red and green of Mexico rather than the red and blue of the U.S. (Figure 5)

Three other airlines issued their own etiquettes: A.S.C.A. (Aerovias Centrales S.A., first absorbed C.A.T. and subsequently absorbed by C.M.A.) in 1931 (Figures 6a & b), L.A.O. (Lineas Aereas Occidentale) in 1934 (Figure 7) and C.A.S. (Compania Aeronautica del Sur) in 1935 (no example available).

All these labels are scarce to very rare.

After the War, LAMSA, Aerovias Reforma, Aerovias Guest S.A., Aerotransportes S.A. and Aeronaves de Mexico all issued their own labels, a story for another time.

There seems to be 2 general sizes of labels dealing with Air race labels:

- 1) Small labels as in 1931 (as in Bulletin 126, pg. 5, item 3) are about 69 x 34 mm. These have been used on regular size covers.
- 2) The large size labels that I have, I have always presumed to be labels (covered in the Thomas catalogs on Air Transportation.) to be placed on baggage, trunks and other luggage. Until I looked on the back of the large label from 1935, 164x129. On the back, it clearly states "paste this on your windshield".

National Races 1934, (a smaller image, 50x25 mm stamped in black, on #6, pg. 6 of Bulletin 126). Label is 195x97 mm. I currently have not seen the small label except the black printed image, on that memorial card.



National Air Races 1931, the larger label is 121.5 x 90 mm, (pg. 5, 3 of PLB 126).



National Air Races 1929, red white and blue label (36x53 mm.) of green cachet from #1 of page 5 of PLB 126.



National Air Races 1932, (41x49 mm.), (red, white, blue and silver.).



Pan American Air Races. Shushan Air Port, No year indicated, 138x150 mm., red, white, blue, green and yellow. However, #5 on pg. 6 of PBL 126, another cover with a cachet gives the year as 1934.



Miami All-American Air Races, 186x125 mm., red and white, form of an airplane.

Mint infers that the gum is without faults. Gum w/hm presumes that the gum has hinge marks or hinge remainders.

No gum can include matt (invisible) gum. To wet a label to see if it has matt gum sort of defeats the purpose of doing no harm. If there is no gum, clean back, and no cancel is the label unused or used? For our purposed, unused?
