Also present were our wives and this made for a wonderful evening. Eric made a donation of some of his privately produced AMLs which will be distributed with next year’s dues letter. Kevin has just completed a book on Australian Registration Labels and it will be published sometime in May. I saw the proof copy and it is a must for any collector of Australian Registration labels. And Eric replied to two questions regarding Australian labels:

On Page 5 of Spring 2017 #125, you asked whether there had been a major reordering of Australian Postal Forms. This apparently happened around 1998/1999. You’ll find a list of the new Form numbers on Pages 235-237 of *The Official Postal Labels of Australia*.



On Page 12 of Summer 2017 #126, you asked the function of the ID RECORDED label. This is a security measure for International Parcels more than 500g. I’ve been ask to show my Driver’s Licence (which is recorded) before the label is placed on the parcel.

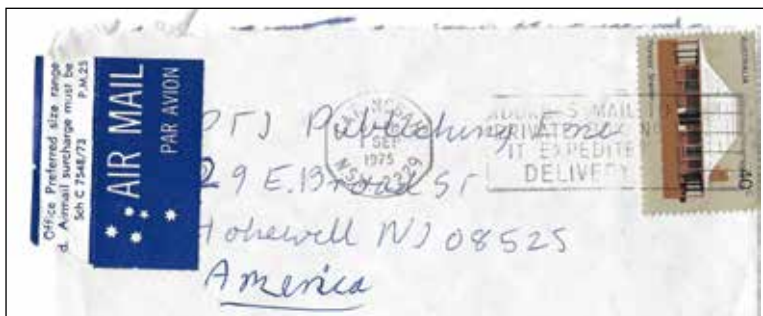

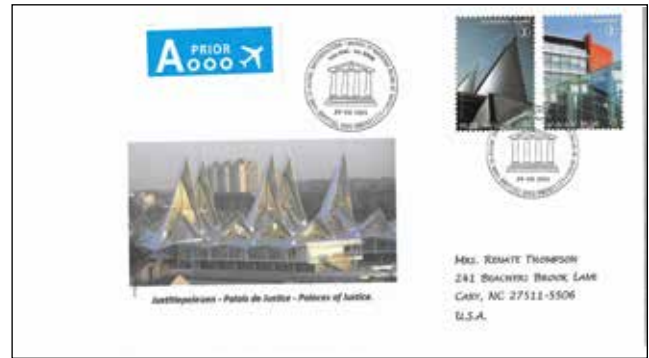
Australia AML mailed 1975, showing reference printing on top of pane..

The complete top margin text according to the above mentioned catalog:

“Use on items outside the Post Office Preferred size range when arimail carriage is required. Airmail surcharge must be paid”



Belgium unlisted AML, mailed 1998, 35x15 mm, imperf.



Belgium unlisted AML 1, mailed 2011, 50x20 mm including white frame, imperf.



Canada unlisted AML, like USA-C-29-30, BUT printed below AIRMAIL, 7 cents per ounce, and ends in U.S. and Canada. faint date cancel looks like 1926



Ceska Republic (new name of country, Bottom AML (dark blue) mailed 1995, rouletted top and bottom, and top label is bright blue and rouletted 3 sides, and mailed 1997. Both 23x16 mm.



German cover mailed 1963, with re-directed from Haus Herwig to Hotel Butterfly in Zurich. Imperforated vertically.



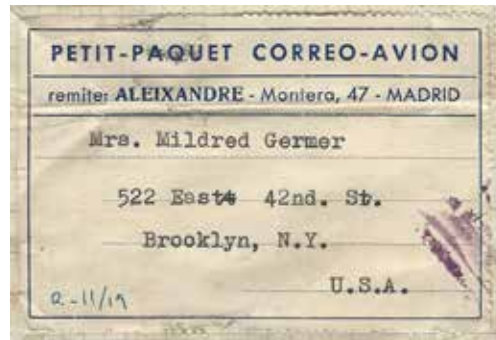
Unlisted yellow (plastic tape like horizon. coil) on Gibraltar cover mailed Feb. 18. 1955

Alexandre in Madrid had his labels printed with the words "Petit-Paquet Correo-Avion". Such large private labels are not common.



A registered airmail cover (with etiquettes or both services) from Kenya to the U.S., 1933. Spectacles were enclosed.

Two "Distribution/par porteur special" labels, one internal the other to Republic of South Africa. Judging from the postage charges, I suspect this is a form of special delivery. Comments?

Gems can be found on the back of covers:



Here is a cover mailed 12/5/1896. (best guess from cancel) The front shows that it was mailed from Pittsburgh, Pa. to Philadelphia. There is a manuscript date, and a receiving cancel from Philadelphia, on the back. Both are also hard to read.

On the back is a blue label 29x18 mm which has the printing : "If not delivered in ten days, RETURN to NATIONAL letter return Association, Chicago Ill".

The only puzzling thing is why one would send a letter from Pittsburgh to Philly, and return the Chicago Ill. You would think it would be returned to Monongahela House.

I still like the label, and do not remember seeing another label like it.

Message from Darus Greathouse, our auctioneer

In a real way, this is your auction. If you do not submit labels/covers and/or label related material for the auction,..... THERE IS NO AUCTION.....! Air mail labels seem to be the most popular (specially unlisted). When you (the owner) set the reserve, and it is too high, it discourages bidding.

I have a back log of unsold material, some of which are duplicates. I have tried to mix the material up. Over the next several auctions, I am going to run this material again. If they do not sell, I intend to return them to their owners. IN THE FUTURE, if the material submitted, does not sale after two sales, I will return them. I suggest that the owners evaluate whether the reserves were set too high. This material can be re-submitted for auction, but it is not fair for me to retain any material for too long of a time. Thank you.

If and when you get auction material returned to you, it would be generous of you to help reinburst me for the postage I used. I will attempt to use nice stamps.

nl= not listed or unknown, as is = please no returns for stated data

ng= no gum ,pm= pencil marks, hm= hinge marks/remainers, as = as submitted by owner

Mint infers that the gum is without faults. Gum w/hm presumes that the gum has hinge marks or hinge remainders.

No gum can include matt (invisible) gum. To wet a label to see if it has matt gum sort of defeats the purpose of doing no harm. If there is no gum, clean back, and no cancel is the label unused or used? For our purposed, unused?
